ACTIVITY PARTICIPATION FORM

Students involved in athletics, cheerleading, or drill team/flag corps shall not possess, use, transmit, traffic in, or be under the influence of illegal/controlled substances such as tobacco in any form, amphetamines, barbiturates, marijuana, narcotic or hallucinogenic drugs, alcohol, or intoxicants of any kind on the school grounds or off the school grounds, or while in training for or participation in a school activity, function, or event. This also includes all violations listed in the penal code, other than minor traffic infractions. The committee will investigate the alleged violation and upon verification that a violation has occurred, the committee will proceed as follows.

Prior to participating in the activities listed above, a student and a parent/guardian must sign a copy of the District's Activity Participation Policy. The signed copy must be on file with the Middle School before the student may participate in these activities. Only one signed policy need be on file for each school year.

1. First Violation:

- a. If a student is in violation, he/she will be suspended for two games or two weeks which ever is longer.
- b. The student will be referred to the School Substance Abuse Team and have a mandatory free assessment and follow the recommendations of the assessment.
- c. Perform any extra duties the head coach of that sport deems acceptable.

2. Second Violation:

- a. If a student is in violation, he/she will be suspended for any remaining contests in that sport season.
- b. The student will be referred to the School Substance Abuse Team and have a mandatory free assessment and follow the recommendations of the assessment.

3. Third Violation:

- a. If a student violates for a third time during middle school, he/she will forfeit the right to participate in any athletic extra-curricular activity until the beginning of that sport season NEXT calendar year.
- b. The student will be referred to the School Substance Abuse Team and have a mandatory free assessment and follow the recommendations.
